

MORVEDRA NOU



Nestled within the Macarella Natural Park, Morvedra Nou is a traditional Menorcan agricultural estate; a lloc dating back to around 1650. For centuries, it was dedicated to farming and livestock, with crops, grazing, and local production. In 1998, it was transformed into a rural hotel, becoming one of the first to receive a license in Menorca, setting a precedent in converting agricultural environments into sustainable hospitality destinations. The property spans 75 hectares, where century-old olive groves, natural trails, and native vegetation coexist with historical remnants.



The Rooms

An exclusive retreat where history blends seamlessly with modern comfort. Designed by Virginia Nieto, the former stables have been transformed into 26 rooms, preserving the original structure while incorporating special features and natural materials that evoke a sense of calm. In every room, luxury is expressed through simplicity, silence, and attention to detail.
