

Each 43-sqm cottage is thoughtfully designed with a loft to comfortably accommodate up to four guests. Access involves a narrow flight of stairs making these cottages less ideal for families with very young children.

12 Garden Cottage – 28sqm

Surrounded by lush greens, the Garden Cottage is a stone's throw from the beach ideal for 2 guests.

2 Family Cottage – 49sqm

Tucked in an idyllic verdant setting, the Family Garden Cottage offers a spacious and cozy retreat for relaxed island living.



BEACHSIDE COTTAGE

12 Beachside Cottage · 32sqm

Located right in front of Miniloc's white sand beach, the charming Beachside Room can comfortably accommodate 3 adult guests.

5 Seaview Rooms- 43sqm

Built on stilts, the Seaview Rooms span two levels, each room ideal for 4 adults and 1 child.
