## Sustainability at Lapa Rios Lodge

Lapa Rios protects over 1000 acres of Central America's last remaining lowland tropical rainforest and runs a Plant-a-Tree reforestation program. The majority of the electricity consumed at the lodge is clean generated by hydroelectric turbines and solar panels. There is an edible garden that produces herbs and greens. Lapa Rios also runs an innovative program, training nature guides to maintain ecotourism in the community as the main source of income.
